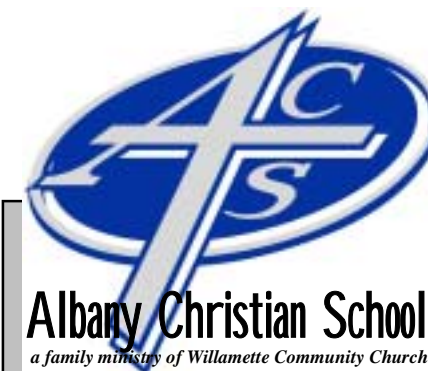
Athletics
